

Encliandra Type Fuchsia Varieties

Abbreviations T. Tube S. Sepals C. corolla or Petals \* Interspecific Hybrid

**BRIAN BREARY** (Breary 1995) T, S, & C - bright deep pink. Large flowers for this type. Upright.

**CORAL BABY** (Drapkin 1989) T, S, & C - bright orangey red. Upright growth.

**FIONA PITTS** (Saunders 1989) T, S, & C - shades of pink. Strong grower.

**GINA BOWMAN** (Morrison 2004) Chance seedling from Marlies de Keijzer. Pinky red flowers and silvery green foliage. The same colouring as parent but both flowers and foliage are much larger.

**JIDDLES** (Iddles) T, S, & C - white. Pale green leaves.

**JUST PINK** (Strickland 1997) T, S, & C - light pink. Foliage is dark green and provides a striking contrast with the light pink flowers.

**KAREN ISLES** (Strickland 1997) T, S, & C - red. Large flowers for this type.

**KATINKA** \* (Goedman 1989) Hybrid of *F. ravenii* x *F. microphylla* subsp. *microphylla*. T, S, & C - bright scarlet. Larger than average flowers.

**LITTLE CAT BELLS** (Travis 1980) T, S, & C - white ageing to red. Slightly scented.

**LOTTIE HOBBY** (Edwards 1839) T, S, & C - deep red. Bushy growth. Hardy.

**LOXHORE LULLABY** (Wright 1987) T, S, & C - bright pink.

**MARLES de KEIJZER\*** (de Keijzer 1999) Hybrid of *F. encliandra* x *F. thymifolia* subsp. *thymifolia*. Red flowers and silvery green foliage.

**MICROCHIP** (Fleming 1990) T & S - pink. C - paler pink.

**MIEKE SARTON** (de Keijzer 1995) T, S, & C - orange. Upright.

**MRS LEE BELTON** (Morrison 2006) T, S, & C - red. Upright growth. Flowers well.

**NICKI FENWICK-RAVEN** (Morrison 2008) (B.F.S. Reg. No. 41) Flowers start white aging to pink then red. It is possible to see all three colours on the plant at the same time.

**OBCYLIN\*** (Beije 1999) Hybrid of *F. obconica* x *F. cylindracea*. T, S, & C peach. A good colour for this type. Self branching.

**OOSJE\*** (Van de Grijp 1973) Hybrid of *F. cylindracea* x *F. microphylla* subsp. *microphylla*. T & S - red. C - white ageing to red. Very small flowers.

**OULTON EMPRESS** (Payne 1998) T, S, & C - pinky white. Mid green glossy leaves. Upright

**OULTON RED IMP** (Payne 1998) T, S, & C - red. Mid green glossy leaves. Upright.

**OULTON TRAVELLERS REST** (Payne 1998) T, S, & C - pink. Medium to large flowers. Dark green foliage.

**RADINGS GERDA** (Reimann 1984) T, S, & C - lavender. Upright growth.

**RADINGS INGE** (Reimann 1980) T & S - red tipped cream. C - orange. Lax growth.

**RADINGS MICHELLE** (Reimann) T, S, & C - pinky white. Mid green glossy leaves. Upright

**SIBORET** (de Boer 2000) T, S, & C - white with a hint of lavender.

**SNOWFLAKE** (Strickland 1998) T, S & C - white. Good for showing.

**T.S.J** (Strickland 1997) T, S, & C - red. Good all rounder.

**WALDFEE** (Travis 1973) T, S, & C - lilac pink. Vigorous grower.

## Encliandra Fuchsia Species

*F. cylindracea* (Lindley 1838 - Mexico & central America) Small orangey red flowers with dark green glossy foliage.

*F. microphylla* subsp. *aprica* (Breedlove 1969) T, S, & C - deep pink. Small dark green glossy foliage.

*F. microphylla* subsp. *hemsleyana* T, S, & C - pearly pink. Small light green foliage.

*F. microphylla* subsp. *hidalgensis* (Munz 1943 - Mexico) T, S, & C - white. Wiry growth.

*F. microphylla* subsp. *quercetorum* (Breedlove 1969) T, S, & C - red. Dark green foliage.

*F. thymifolia* subsp. *minimiflora* (Hemsley 1888 Central America) T & S - white to pink. C - white ageing to pale purple. Foliage lanceolate in shape. Upright growth.

*F. thymifolia* subsp. *thymifolia* (Humboldt, Bonpland & Kunth 1823 Central America) Tiny white flowers ageing to red. Small round foliage. Straggly lax growth.
